Altar fire equipment

At side of bunker: metal bin for COLD ash.

2 small BBQs (can be used for fires) Further altar fire equipment in bunker in 1st field.

4 folding chairs & a long table
(suitable for use in the fields.)

Approx 30 small plastic chairs and some low tables. (Brownie & Rainbow size)

A few sitters & a groundsheet.

Approx 3 pond dipping nets.

Approx 36 tennis style foam balls

8 Badminton rackets, 2 nets and 7 shuttlecocks

2 tennis rackets and 2 nets

4 sets of boules

Plenty of miscellaneous bean bags

12 frisbees

Quoits

Sports bibs

8 cones to use as markers

1 table tennis set (1 net. 2 ping pong balls.)

4 foam footballs

1 football with bell (for blindfold games - with safety precautions!)

Foam dominoes 4"x 2" 50x100mm each tile

2 balance rockers

3 spinning plates each with a sticks.

6 x throwing horseshoes with post

3 sets of "can stilts".

4 x plastic skipping ropes

6 balls attached to cups for throwing

12 bean bags & a target bean bag: in a drawstring bag.

Quick cups stacking game (12 cups)

1 x 24mm footrope for rope bridge

2 x 8mm handrail ropes

A good number of 8mm for lashings
